## **Friday Nights at the Morse Resume Nov. 7**

WINTER PARK, Fla. — A new season of “Friday Nights at the Morse” begins Nov. 7 with an exciting line-up of live music, art demonstrations and family tours.

From November through April, the museum is open until 8 p.m. on Friday nights. Admission is free after 4 p.m. To enhance the visitor’s tour through the Morse galleries, the museum has booked live music every second Friday of the month and every Friday evening throughout the holidays: Nov. 28 through Dec. 26.

The musicians and musical groups will play from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. The music schedule is as follows:

- **Nov. 14** Victoria Lynn Schultz (harp)
- **Nov. 28** Harpist Bizarre Quartet (harp, flute, guitar and bass)
- **Dec. 5** Lynn Peghiny (piano)
- **Dec. 12** Beautiful Music—BellaMusica Ensemble (mandolin, bass, violin and flute)
- **Dec. 19** Beautiful Music—A Star and The Wise Guys (guitar, flute and upright bass)
- **Dec. 26** Beautiful Music—Three Flutes Only
- **Jan. 9** “Sweet Sounds” of Beautiful Music (flute, violin, jazz guitar and upright bass)

- **Feb. 13** Beautiful Music Muse Duo (classical guitar and flute)
- **March 13** Celtic Crossings (Celtic harp, flute and violin)
- **April 10** Beautiful Music Muse Trio (violin, cello and flute)

During other Friday evening programs, museum visitors will have a chance to see artists demonstrate their crafts. These free art demonstrations include a take-home activity for children. The demonstrations begin at 6 p.m. in the Hugh F. and Jeannette G. McKean Pavilion (just behind the museum) and are followed at 7 p.m. by a family tour through the galleries.
