

Getting to the Morse Museum

The Museum's gallery expansion project is now officially underway. While this is exciting news, it will present some parking challenges until the new wing opens in the winter of 2011. The construction site is fenced off, and throughout the construction phase, visitors will have access to the Museum's parking lot only from Cole Avenue, a one-way street going west from Park Avenue. We apologize for this inconvenience and thank you in advance for your patience.

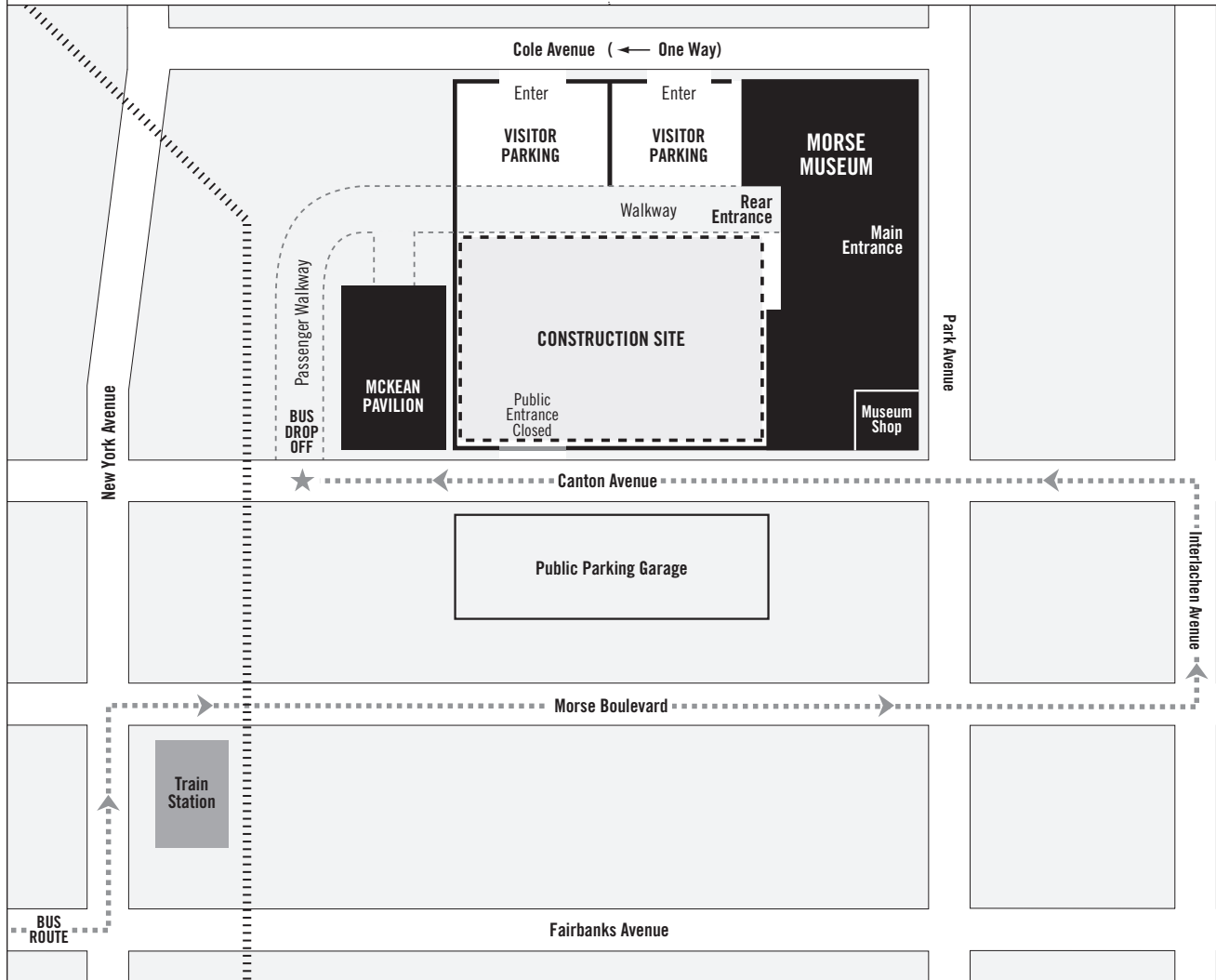
Visitor Parking: During construction, there will be sufficient parking for anyone wanting to visit the Museum, but it may be somewhat further away than it is now, and it may at times be dusty. Visitors may also park in the designated public parking spaces on the first, fourth, and fifth floors of the Park Place garage on Canton Avenue across the street from the Museum. The first level is limited to three-hour parking. The fourth and fifth levels have no time restrictions.

Vans and Buses: Small buses and vans may park in the visitor parking lot along with cars. While construction is underway, large buses will need to follow the route on the map to drop off tour participants at the McKean Pavilion. The group will be able to walk from the Pavilion's driveway entrance to the covered walkway leading to the rear entrance of the Museum.

Bus traffic is regulated by the City of Winter Park. Tour operators should contact the Traffic Manager in the Winter Park Public Works Department at (407) 599-3411 to notify officials of their schedules and parking requirements. Buses may park in City-designated loading zones, on the street where there are available parking spaces, or in a lot specified by the City Traffic Manager. Buses are not permitted on Park Avenue.

Bus Directions: From I-4, exit at Fairbanks Avenue (Exit 87) and travel east on Fairbanks toward Winter Park 1.5 miles. At the intersection with New York Avenue (traffic light), buses should turn left and proceed to Morse Boulevard (traffic light). Turn right. Proceed east across Park Avenue to Interlachen Avenue. Turn left onto Interlachen. Take the second left onto Canton Avenue. Proceed west toward the Museum, cross Park Avenue, and stop on Canton in front of the McKean Pavilion to drop off members of the tour group. Do not pull into the Pavilion driveway.
