**Morse Museum to Close for Hurricane Dorian**

WINTER PARK—Due to severe weather conditions and public safety concerns caused by Hurricane Dorian, the galleries and offices of The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art will be closed **Monday, September 2**, through **Wednesday, September 4**.

The Morse, located at 445 N. Park Avenue, is home to the world's most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany (1848–1933). Regular hours are 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday; and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday. November through April, the Museum is open until 8 p.m. on Friday. Regular admission is \$6 for adults, \$5 for seniors, \$1 for students, and free for children younger than age 12. November through April, all visitors are admitted free 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Friday.
